NMP accepts walk-in applicants for Assessment (NAC)

TACLOBAN CITY – The National Maritime Polytechnic (NMP) Tacloban Complex has started accepting walk-in clients for assessment since July 2011. Qualified walk-in clients shall submit the following requirements in applying for assessment leading towards issuance of Certificate of Proficiency (COP):

Requirements

- Certificate of training completion (valid within 5 years preceding application) in the following courses: Basic Safety Training (BST), Advance Training in Firefighting (ATFF), Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats other than Fast Rescue Boats (PSCRB) and Medical Emergency First Aid (MEFA)
- Medical certificate (physically and medically fit)
- Certificate of sea service (at least 6 months for PSCRB only)
- 2 pcs. Passport size ID picture (in uniform with nametag)
- Long brown envelope
- Assessment fee – P700.00
- Processing fee - P240.00
